



GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation)

On May 25, 2018, a new EU regulation will begin throughout Europe. GDPR replaces the Personal Data Act (P U L). Much is the same as before, but GDPR puts higher demands on companies and focuses on the rights you have as our customer. You are entitled to request information about what personal information we have about you and what purpose we need to get personal information. We as a company are responsible for processing your personal information as we do by yourself or as another company on behalf of us.

Personal data refers to data that can be linked to a physically living person.

When you are in a queue with us for a home or have a rental agreement with us we need data to manage services such as queue handling, rental visas etc.

Personal data that are necessary to process in connection with the application are:

Name

Date of birth

Address

Phone number

E-mail address

Economic conditions

Desired accommodation (apartment size, accommodation, area)

Employer's contact details

Thinning

The basic requirement is that personal data can only be retained as long as necessary.

Therefore, when the rental relationship has expired, the personal data should be shredded.

Exception is that information in the lease is necessary to monitor outstanding claims relating to the lease or where the lease has been terminated due to misconduct.

Your rights

It is our duty to process personal data in a correct and relevant manner.

You as a customer have the right to check that the information we have about you is correct.
